ENROLLMENT

During the COVID-19 pandemic Molalla River School District will continue to enroll students. Students (including foreign exchange students) will continue to be enrolled in MRSD as per current standards and guidelines. Students will have the option for hybrid learning or full-time online academy. Students may change placement of full time online status on a trimester by trimester basis.

Students who are absent due to LPHA restrictions for COVID-19 for 10 or more consecutive school days will not be “10-day dropped” or disenrolled. If the system automatically dis-enrolls the student, then the student will be re-enrolled.

ATTENDANCE

As per Oregon Revised Statute Chapter 339, students ages 6 to 18 are required to attend school full time, except where exemptions of compulsory school attendance are defined in 339.030. For the purposes of COVID-19 Hybrid, a period equivalent to that required of children attending public schools, as defined in ORS 339.030(1)(a) will be combined of on campus learning and online learning to allow for staggering of populations in the buildings to maintain physical distancing.

General Attendance

- Student attendance will be taken by the identified teacher of record, not another staff member
- Attendance for students who are enrolled either full time online and/or hybrid will be recorded and reported according to ODE standards and guidelines

In Person Attendance

- Enhanced attendance procedures will be endorsed to ensure accurate attendance records are created and maintained for the purposes of contact tracing. This includes extra time during attendance.
- Additional time allotted during morning attendance will allow time for passive/ visual screening of students for illness.

Online Attendance

- Students engaged in part time or full time distancing learning will have mechanism to provide attendance and participation validation via direct interaction with the teacher(s) and specialist(s).
- Students engaged in full time online and/or hybrid will have a mechanism to provide attendance and participation validation via direct interaction with the teacher of record.
- The appropriate licensed instructional staff member will provide a two-way communication method for students to check in at least twice a week to determine whether adequate student progress is being met.
- Part time students receiving online and/or hybrid instruction will be reported according to ODE guidelines and appropriate program types.
